- April 16 see's Two large North West Foundation Trusts sign up to our Asset Management Framework. Leaseguard to deliver savings across their asset maintenance portfolio.
- Launched in 2015, our Gas framework is heating up with more than 20 trusts now signed up and saving money with Gazprom. Our energy partner tracks the wholesale energy market to ensure this framework gives Trusts the opportunity to procure energy at a very competitive rate. Early adopters have demonstrated average savings of 15% in comparison to other national frameworks, due to our frameworks transparent costs which offer a lower cost to serve and risk margin.
